



2026 DISPLAY AGREEMENT / ENTRY FORM

RETURN FORM BY JUNE 12, 2026

**DISPLAY VIEWING WILL BE THURSDAY-FRIDAY JULY 09 & 10
at RIVER BLUFF EDUCATION CENTER**

AGREEMENT: Entry Rules and Regulations:

- In general, Display participants will choose between the standard categories: **Art Pottery, Dinnerware, Memorabilia or Stoneware**. In addition, there are the **Mixed Media** (photos, videos, paintings and other creative media) and the **Dennis Yaeggi Rare Item Awards**. The Display Manager retains the right to reclassify any display to maintain a fair competition and well-rounded Display Room.
- Art Pottery, Dinnerware, Memorabilia and Stoneware Displays can be Mini or Full-Size Display or Vignette Entries for 2026. They will be judged as one group of each category. Space is limited for Vignette's.
- Displays may be submitted exclusively by members of the Red Wing Collectors Society who are registered for CrockFest 2026. Each entry will receive one regular 2026 Commemorative for participation.
- Limit - Three members per Display are allowed entry into the Display Room during Setup and Removal
- Displays must remain set up during the Display hours published in the 2026 CrockFest Schedule.
- The Display Manager and the RWCS Board of Directors will make reasonable effort to safeguard the property of the Displayers. However, the Display Manager, the RWCS, and/or the RWCS Board of Directors will not assume any responsibility for lost, stolen, or damaged articles.
- The RWCS will provide 24-hour security for the loan period either by contracted security personnel during Display hours or by locking the room when the Display Room is not in operation.
- There are TEN possible awards: Best of Show and People's Choice in each of the standard categories (Art Pottery, Dinnerware, Memorabilia, and Stoneware), and ONE for People's Choice Dennis Yaeggi Rare Item Award and ONE Mixed Media Award. The winning display member will receive a special commemorative. If a Display wins both Best of Show and People's Choice, only one special commemorative is awarded.

NON-COMPETITIVE CATEGORIES are not eligible to win a Special Commemorative. Any Chapter setting up a Display receives one regular commemorative for participation. These Displays by Chapters or the RWCS Commemorative Committee may include signage identifying the Displayer. There is no limit to the number of items displayed in this category.

Rules of Participation

- Art pottery, dinnerware, stoneware and memorabilia displays will consist of pottery/memorabilia items plus educational material, drawings, etc. that explain, describe or enhance the display. TABLES PROVIDED WILL BE 5' x 2'. ENTRIES MUST FIT ON THIS SIZE TABLE. IF INTERESTED IN DOING A VIGNETTE PLEASE CONTACT THE DISPLAY MANAGER AS SPACE IS LIMITED.
- All Displays must have an accurate inventory of all items on Display at the time of set up. A copy of this list must be supplied to the Display Committee. The inventory list will be checked and signed by a Display Committee member upon completion of set up and before removal of any Display. If no list provided, the Display team will take a picture when display is set up and when taken down.
- Each item on Display must be labeled with a sticker to include the member's name, member number and phone. Items notable to have a sticker (paper items, etc.) will be detailed on the inventory.
- The Display cannot include any signage identifying member, numbers, "For Sale", or "Looking For" signs, etc.
- NO ONE IS ALLOWED behind the ropes to a Display from Thursday 12:00 am until Friday 12:30 pm.
- Signs should be easily read from a distance of at least four feet.
- Insurance is the responsibility of the Members as lender/owner to the RWCS CrockFest Display Room.
- **DISPLAY SETUP TIME* IS THURSDAY 8-9:30 AM. REMOVAL IS FRIDAY 12:30-2:00 PM. (*or if set up by appt. Wed. 1-3 pm)**

VOTING/JUDGING: All general displays will be judged by People's Choice (CrockFest attendees). Best of Show Awards will be determined by a team of judges appointed by the Display Committee using the following criteria: a) quality of pieces, b) representation and relation of types of pieces, c) related props, etc. that enhance the display and d) educational value/materials. Rare Items will be judged for the Dennis Yaeggi Rare Item Award by People's Choice. Winners will be announced on Friday at the Annual Members Business Meeting.
